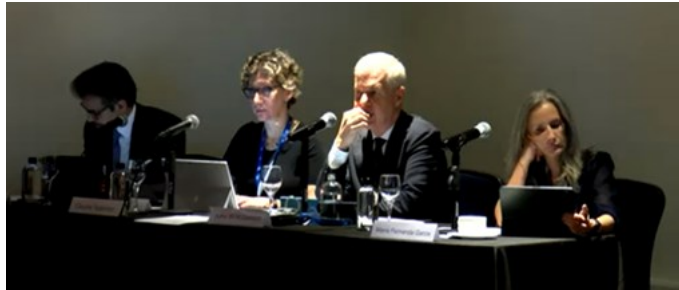

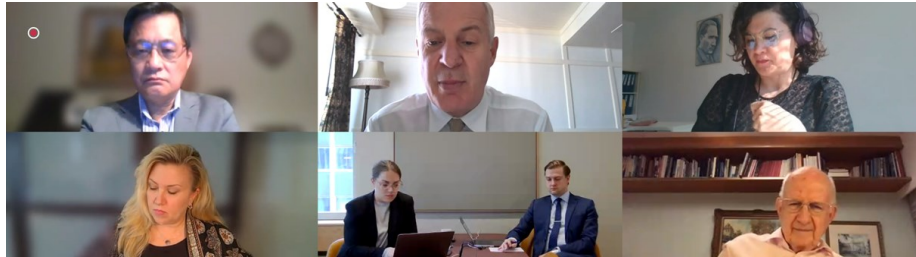

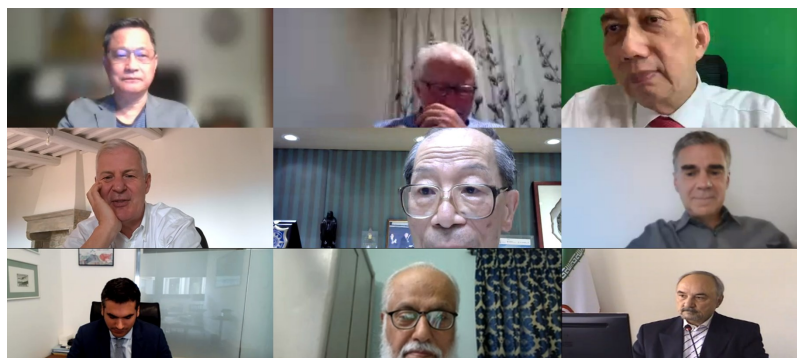
ICC Knowledge Sharing Session Part III meeting

The meeting started with opening remarks by Mr. John Denton, ICC Secretary General followed by the updated on the ICC response on Ukraine/Russia conflict by supporting business on various aspects such as

- Participation in UN Secretary General’s steering Group on the Food, Energy and Finance
- ICC engagement with IMF and World Bank Group calling for coordinated action to ensure interventions cushion the trade shock caused by the crisis
- Engagement with key development banks to ensure appropriate support to boost the capacity of trade finance market in the context of rising commodity prices
- Five Point Plan released to maintain the viability of Ukrainian private sector
- Launch of new Center of Entrepreneurship for Ukraine
- Guidance for SMEs on sanctions compliance

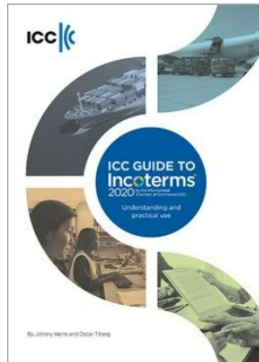
